# what's the difference?

Possessive adjectives (possessive determiners)	Possessive pronouns
possessive adjective + noun	possessive pronoun ( <i>+ no noun</i> )
<b>my</b> This is my book.	<b>mine</b> This book is mine.
<b>your</b> Is this your umbrella?	<b>yours</b> Is this yours?
<b>his</b> He lent me his jacket.	<b>his</b> This isn't my jacket. It's his.
<b>her</b> I borrowed her car.	<b>hers</b> The car is hers.
<b>its</b> Do you like my doll? These are its clothes.	----- <i>We avoid using "its" alone as a possessive pronoun.</i>
<b>our</b> A lot of our friends came to our party.	<b>ours</b> That car is ours.
<b>their</b> Their house is lovely.	<b>theirs</b> That house is theirs.

# POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS

## POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS

A possessive pronoun is a pronoun that is used to indicate possession or ownership.

- This pen is **my** pen, not **your** pen.
- This pen is **mine**, not **yours**.

| <b>MINE</b>   | • This is my laptop. It's <b>mine</b> .                 |
| <b>YOURS</b>  | • These glasses are mine, not <b>yours</b> .            |
| <b>HIS</b>    | • This is my brother 's book. It's <b>his</b> .         |
| <b>HERS</b>   | • He offered to swap his camera for <b>hers</b> .       |
| <b>OURS</b>   | • I'll show you to your room. <b>Ours</b> is next door. |
| <b>YOURS</b>  | • The house is <b>yours</b> .                           |
| <b>THEIRS</b> | • The ship is <b>theirs</b> .                           |

# POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES

## SUBJECT PRONOUN

<b>I</b>	I have a shirt.
<b>YOU</b>	<b>You</b> have a book.
<b>HE</b>	<b>He</b> has a pillow.
<b>SHE</b>	<b>She</b> has a dog.
<b>IT</b>	<b>It</b> has a bone.
<b>WE</b>	<b>We</b> have a bird.
<b>YOU</b>	<b>You</b> have a house.
<b>THEY</b>	<b>They</b> have a car.

## POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE

<b>MY</b>	<b>My</b> shirt is green.
<b>YOUR</b>	<b>Your</b> book is new.
<b>HIS</b>	<b>His</b> pillow is soft.
<b>HER</b>	<b>Her</b> dog is small.
<b>ITS</b>	<b>Its</b> bone is old.
<b>OUR</b>	<b>Our</b> bird is noisy.
<b>YOUR</b>	<b>Your</b> house is big.
<b>THEIR</b>	<b>Their</b> car is slow.

**YOUR = Possessive Adjective**

- You need to bring **your** dictionary.

**YOU'RE = You are (contraction)**

- You're an excellent student.

**ITS = Possessive Adjective**

- The dog played with **its** ball.

**IT'S = It is (contraction)**

- **It's** very hot right now.
